INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

#### TO THE MEMBERS OF SMAAASH ENTERTAINMENT PRIVATE LIMITED

Report on the Consolidated Financial Statements

We have audited the accompanying consolidated financial statements of Smaaash Entertainment Private Limited (hereinafter referred to as "the Holding Company") and its subsidiaries (the Holding Company and its subsidiaries together referred to as "the Group"), comprising of the Consolidated Balance Sheet as at 31st March, 2017, the Consolidated Statement of Profit and Loss, the Consolidated Cash Flow Statement for the year then ended, and a summary of the significant accounting policies and other explanatory information (hereinafter referred to as "the consolidated financial statements")

Management's Responsibility for the Consolidated Financial Statements

The Holding Company's Board of Directors is responsible for the preparation of these consolidated financial statements in terms of the requirements of the Companies Act, 2013 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") that give a true and fair view of the consolidated financial position, consolidated financial performance and consolidated cash flows of the Group in accordance with the accounting principles generally accepted in India, including the Accounting Standards prescribed under Section 133 of the Act. The respective Board of

Directors of the companies included in the Group are responsible for maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Act for safeguarding the assets of the Group and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; the selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and the design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls, that were operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and

completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the financial statements that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, which have been used for the purpose of preparation of the consolidated financial statements by the Directors of the Holding Company, as aforesaid.

Auditor's Responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these consolidated financial statements based on our audit. In conducting our audit, we have taken into account the provisions of the Act, the accounting and auditing standards and matters which are required to be included in the audit report under the provisions of the Act and the Rules made thereunder.

We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing specified under Section 143(10) of the Act. Those Standards require that we comply with ethical

Requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the consolidated financial statements are free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and the disclosures in the consolidated financial statements. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the consolidated financial statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal financial control relevant to the Holding Company's preparation of the consolidated financial statements that give a true and fair view in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of the accounting policies used and the reasonableness of the accounting estimates made by the Holding Company's Board of Directors, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the consolidated financial statements.

We believe that the audit evidence obtained by us, is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion on the consolidated financial statements.

Opinion

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the aforesaid consolidated financial statements give the information required by the Act in the manner so required and give a true and fair view in conformity with the accounting principles generally accepted in India, of the consolidated state of affairs of the Group, as at 31st March, 2017, and their consolidated loss and their consolidated cash flows for the year ended on that date.

#### Other Matters

(a) We did not audit the financial statements of four subsidiaries included in the Group whose financial statements reflect total assets of Rs. 7,276.59 lakhs as at 31st March, 2017 and total revenues of Rs. 1,402.27 lakhs and net cash flows amounting to Rs. 203.42 lakhs for the year ended on that date, as considered in the respective standalone financial statements of the companies included in the Group. These financial statements have been audited by the other auditors whose reports have been furnished to us, and our opinion on the consolidated financial statements, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these subsidiaries, is based solely on the report of such other auditors.

(b) Our opinion on the consolidated financial statements, and our report on Other Legal and Regulatory Requirements below is not modified in respect of the above matters with respect to our reliance on the work done and the reports of the other auditors.

Report on Other Legal and Regulatory Requirements

As required by Section 143(3) of the Act, based on our audit, we report, to the extent applicable, that:

(a) We have sought and obtained all the information and explanations which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary for the purposes of our audit of the aforesaid consolidated financial statements.

(b) In our opinion, proper books of account as required by law relating to preparation of the aforesaid consolidated financial statements have been kept so far as it appears from our examination of those books, returns and the reports of the other auditors.

(c) The Consolidated Balance Sheet, the Consolidated Statement of Profit and Loss, and the Consolidated Cash Flow Statement dealt with by this Report are in agreement with the relevant books of account maintained for the purpose of preparation of the consolidated financial statements

(d) In our opinion, the aforesaid consolidated financial statements comply with the Accounting Standards prescribed under Section 133 of the Act.

(e) On the basis of the written representations received from the directors of the Holding Company as on 31st March, 2017 taken on record by the Board of Directors of the Holding Company and the reports of the statutory auditors of its subsidiary companies none of the directors of the Group companies is disqualified as on 31st March, 2017 from being appointed as a director in terms of Section 164 (2) of the Act.

(f) With respect to the adequacy of the internal financial controls over financial reporting and the operating effectiveness of such controls, refer to our separate Report in "Annexure A", which is based on the auditors' reports of the Holding company and its subsidiary companies incorporated in India. Our report expresses an unmodified opinion on the adequacy and operating effectiveness of the Holding company's/ subsidiary company's incorporated in India internal financial controls over financial reporting

(g) With respect to the other matters to be included in the Auditor's Report in accordance with Rule 11 of the Companies (Audit and Auditor's) Rules, 2014, as amended, in our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us:

i. The consolidated financial statements disclose the impact of pending litigations on the consolidated financial position of the Group. Refer Note 30 to the consolidated financial statements.

iii) Capital Work in Progress / Intangible assets under development

Projects under which assets are not ready for their intended use are carried at cost, comprising direct cost and related incidental expenses.

- e. Depreciation / Amortization
- i) Property, plant and equipments:

Depreciation on Property, plant and equipments is provided on straight line method, at the rates prescribed under part C of schedule II of the Companies Act, 2013 except as under:

- Leasehold Improvements are amortized over the unexpired period of lease on a straight line basis.

- Individual assets costing up to Rs.5,000 are depreciated at the rate of 100% prorata over a period of one year from the date of purchase.

- Depreciation on SEUL tangible fixed asssets is provided on straight line method over the estimated useful life of the assets, as determined by management.

ii) Intangible Assets:

Intangible assets are amortized on a straight line basis over the estimated useful life of 8 years except as under;

- Software and software licenses are amortized over their estimated useful lives of 2.5 years.

- Player rights are amortized over the period of contract with the players.

### f. Impairment of assets

The carrying values of assets / cash generating units at each balance sheet date are reviewed for impairment if any indication of impairment exists.

If the carrying amount of the assets exceed the estimated recoverable amount, an impairment is recognized for such excess amount. The impairment loss is recognized as an expense in the Statement of Profit and Loss, unless the asset is carried at revalued amount, in which case any impairment loss of the revalued asset is treated as a revaluation decrease to the extent a revaluation reserve is available for that asset.

The recoverable amount is the greater of the net selling price and their value in use. Value in use is arrived at by discounting the future cash flows to their present value based on an appropriate discount factor.

### g. Investments

To state current investments at lower of cost and fair value; and long term investments, including in subsidiaries and associate, at cost. Where applicable, provision is made to recognise a decline, other than temporary, in valuation of long term investments.

#### h. Revenue recognition

Revenue is recognized when it is earned and no significant uncertainty as to its realization or collection exists and is recognized as follows:

- Gaming as and when the games are played by patrons.
- Sale of food and beverages upon their delivery to customers.
- Banquet / party sales when event take place.
- Product sales revenue from sale of gaming products recognised upon their delivery.

Balance in card beyond 6 months of active usage lapsed and the same is recognised as income.

Interest income is accounted on accrual basis. Dividend income is accounted for when the right to receive it is established.

i. Employee benefits

Employee benefits include provident fund, employee state insurance scheme, gratuity fund and compensated absences.

### Defined contribution plans

Contribution to provident fund and employee state insurance scheme by the group are considered as defined contribution plan and are charged as an expense based on amount of contribution required to be made and when services are rendered by the employee.

#### Defined benefit plans

For defined benefit plans in the form of gratuity fund, the cost of providing benefits is determined using the Projected Unit Credit method, with actuarial valuations being carried out at each Balance Sheet date. Actuarial gains and losses are recognized in the Consolidated Statement of Profit and Loss in the period in which they occur. Past service cost is recognized immediately to the extent that the benefits are already vested and otherwise is amortized on a straight-line basis over the average period until the benefits become vested. The retirement benefit obligation recognized in the Consolidated Balance Sheet represents the present value of the defined benefit obligation as adjusted for unrecognized past service cost, as reduced by the fair value of scheme assets. Any asset resulting from this calculation is limited to past service cost, plus the present value of available refunds and reductions in future contributions to the schemes.

### Short-term employee benefits

The undiscounted amount of short-term employee benefits expected to be paid in exchange for the services rendered by employees are recognized during the year when the employees render the service. These benefits include compensated absences which are expected to occur within twelve months after the end of the period in which the employee renders the related service. The cost of short-term compensated absences is accounted as under :

- in case of accumulated compensated absences, when employees render the services that increase their entitlement of future compensated absences; and
- in case of non-accumulating compensated absences, when the absences occur.

#### Long-term employee benefits

Compensated absences which are not expected to occur within twelve months after the end of the period in which the employee renders the related service are recognized as a liability at the present value of the defined benefit obligation as at the Balance Sheet date less the fair value of the plan assets out of which the obligations are expected to be settled.

### j. Inventories

Inventories are valued at lower of cost and net realizable value. Cost of inventories includes cost of purchases and other costs incurred in bringing the inventories to their present location and condition. Cost is determined on the Weighted Average method basis.

### k. Taxation

Current tax is the determined on the basis of taxable income and tax credit computed for each of the entities in the Group in accordance with the applicable tax rates and the provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961 and other applicable tax laws.

Deferred tax is recognized on timing differences, being the differences between the taxable income and the accounting income that originate in one period and are capable of reversal in one or more subsequent periods. Deferred tax is measured using the tax rates and the tax laws enacted or substantively enacted as at the reporting date. Deferred tax liabilities are recognized for all timing differences. Deferred tax assets are recognized for timing differences of items other than unabsorbed depreciation and carry

forward losses only to the extent that reasonable certainty exists that sufficient future taxable income will be available against which these can be realized. However, if there are unabsorbed depreciation and carry forward of losses and items relating to capital losses, deferred tax assets are recognized only if there is virtual certainty supported by convincing evidence that there will be sufficient future taxable income available to realize the assets. Deferred tax assets and liabilities are offset if such items relate to taxes on income levied by the same governing tax laws and the group has a legally enforceable right for such set off. Deferred tax assets are reviewed at each balance sheet date for their realisability.

The group offsets deferred tax assets and deferred tax liabilities, advance income tax and provision for tax, if it has a legally enforceable right and these related to taxes in income levies by the same governing taxation laws.

l. Leases

Lease arrangements where the risks and rewards incidental to ownership of an asset substantially vest with the lessor are recognized as operating leases. Lease rentals under operating leases are recognized in the Consolidated Statement of Profit and Loss on a straight-line basis over the lease term.

m. Foreign currency transactions

Transactions in foreign currencies entered are accounted at the exchange rates prevailing on the date of the transaction or at rates that closely approximate the rate at the date of the transaction. Foreign currency monetary items (other than derivative contracts) outstanding at the balance sheet date are restated at the year-end rates. Exchange differences arising on settlement / restatement of foreign currency monetary assets and liabilities are recognized as income or expense in the Consolidated Statement of Profit and Loss.

### n. Provisions and contingencies

A provision is recognized when the group has a present obligation as a result of past events and it is probable that an outflow of resources will be required to settle the obligation in respect of which a reliable estimate can be made. Provisions (excluding retirement benefits) are not discounted to their present value and are determined based on the best estimate required to settle the obligation at the balance sheet date. These are reviewed at each balance sheet date and adjusted to reflect the current best estimates. Contingent liabilities are disclosed in the Notes. Contingent assets are not recognized in the financial statements.

o. Translation of integral and non-integral foreign operation

The financial statements of an integral foreign operation are translated as if the transactions of the foreign operation had been those of the Company itself.

In translating the financial statements of a non-integral foreign operation for incorporation in the financial statements, the assets and liabilities, both monetary and non-monetary, of the non-integral foreign operation are translated at the closing rate; and income and expense items of the non-integral foreign operation are translated at weighted average rates, which approximate the actual exchange rates. All resulting exchange differences are accumulated in a foreign currency translation reserve until the disposal of the net investment.

On the disposal of a non-integral foreign operation, the cumulative amount of the exchange differences which had been deferred and which relate to that operation are recognized as income or as an expense in the same period in which the gain or loss on disposal is recognized.

h. Revenue recognition

Revenue is recognized when it is earned and no significant uncertainty as to its realization or collection exists and is recognized as follows:

- Gaming - as and when the games are played by patrons.

- Sale of food and beverages upon their delivery to customers.
- Banquet / party sales when event take place.
- Product sales revenue from sale of gaming products recognised upon their delivery.

Balance in card beyond 6 months of active usage lapsed and the same is recognised as income.

Interest income is accounted on accrual basis. Dividend income is accounted for when the right to receive it is established.
